## Electives

### Interdisciplinary focus

- nearly all modules of the faculty can be chosen (but only some of them are in English)
- different management modules
- Courses from other universities (outside Germany) can be acknowledged given that they are comparable
- special modules, projects or seminars
- Catalogue of the modules: please check your examination regulations



## Seminars

- Familiarize yourself intensively with a topic!
- **Scope:** 10 ECTS
- You have to take at least one seminar, but you can take more if you want to. The second one will be listed at „Electives“.
- Usually term paper + presentation
- Application during the semester for next semester through the Office of the Dean of Studies.

## Master Thesis

- **Scope:** 30 ECTS
- 6 months to write
- Application process for thesis supervision runs through the Studiendekanat at predefined date once per semester
- Application for supervision one semester in advance
- Thesis must be written in economics

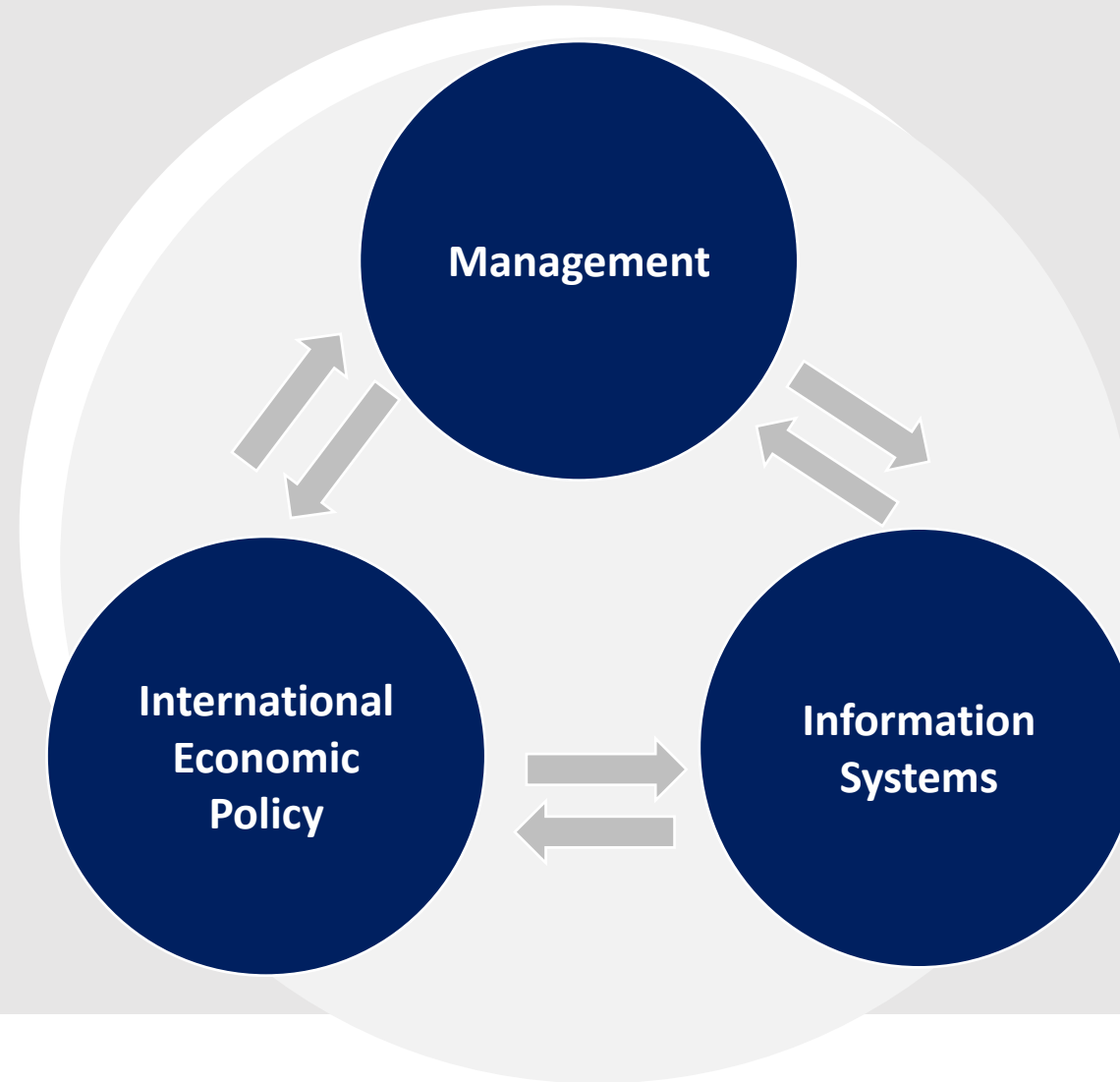
## General framework

- Fixed registration period for exams
- Exams can be retaken at will (until passed)
- If no degree in the 6th semester - first-time failure; last chance: 7th semester
- In leave of absence: no first attempts to take exams possible (exception: failed exams from previous semesters)
- Examinations usually 60 minutes



## Change between master programmes

- Application 1st semester
- Maximum credit of 29 ECTS credits
- Change to a higher semester currently excluded

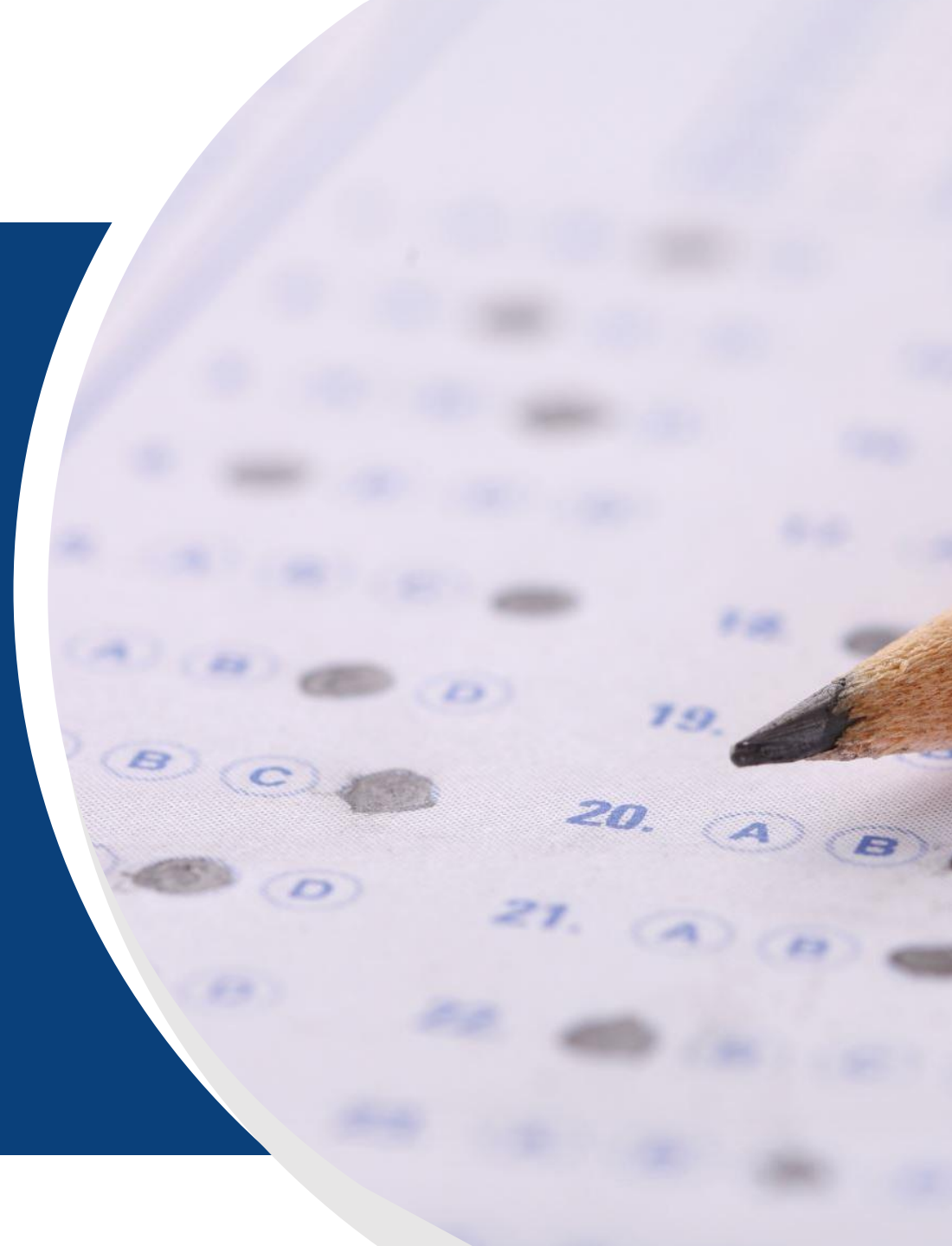
