Concept of the Patent

According to Sec. 1 (1) PatG, patents are granted for <u>inventions</u> in all fields of technology, provided that they

- are new
- involve an inventive step and
- are susceptible of industrial application.

An <u>invention</u> is a teaching for technical action, with which a technical problem (also called task) is solved.

A teaching is <u>technical</u> if it makes use of controllable natural forces outside of human intellectual activity to achieve a causally foreseeable result (BGH, GRUR 1977, 96 - *Dispositionsprogramm*).
