

FAQs about the exam for

Marketing for Start-ups (vhb) – Winter Semester 25/26

- 1. Do I have to submit all 2 parts of the exam to pass the course?**
 - Yes. All 2 parts are mandatory. If one part is missing or fails, the entire module is considered failed.
- 2. Do I need to register for the exam?**
 - Yes. You can register for the exam on time via the vhb.
- 3. Can I still register or deregister after the deadline?**
 - No. The deadlines are binding.
- 4. Which company should I analyze?**
 - You will use your own fictional company as a basis. We will provide you with the framework conditions (industry, size, etc.).
- 5. Which sources may I use?**
 - Permitted:
 - Official company sources (websites, social media)
 - Reputable online sources (e.g., Tagesschau, FAZ, Statista)
 - Reference books, textbooks, and journals (e.g., VHB ranking)
 - Not permitted: Wikipedia or sources without clear authorship.
- 6. Can I choose my own group?**
 - Yes. You can form groups of four people yourself. There will be a survey to determine the groups. Alternatively, we will be happy to assign you to a group.
- 7. How do we divide up the group performance?**
 - The chapters and subchapters can be divided individually. Each contribution must be clearly assigned to one person.
- 8. What if it doesn't work out in the group?**
 - Group work is part of the module. In the event of serious problems, the work may be written individually (with a reduced number of pages, same requirements).
- 9. Can I write the paper in German?**
 - No. The course and exams are currently only available in English. If you would like to take the course in German, please register for the parallel course "Marketing für Start-ups (vhb)", which is held in German.
- 10. Where do I submit my exam results?**
 - Via the course room in WueCampus. One upload per group is sufficient. For large video files, please use Gigamove – the accompanying file must still be uploaded to WueCampus.

11. I missed the deadline – can I submit my application later??

- No. Late submissions cannot be considered.

12. What should I do if I encounter technical problems shortly before submission?

- Allow sufficient time. If you encounter any problems:
 - Submit by email before the deadline
 - Attach a screenshot
 - Email to: **marketing.start-ups@uni-wuerzburg.de**
 - Files received after the deadline will not be considered.

13. Is there a template or sample work available?

- No, not at present. Please refer to the formal guidelines in the “Information on examination performance” section.

14. What criteria are used for evaluation?

- Quality of analysis
- Creativity of content
- Stringency of argumentation
- Presentation (graphics, style)
- Formalities (citation, language, layout)

15. Do I have to cite sources?

- Yes. Without verifiable sources, the achievement will not be evaluated.

16. Are there any exclusion criteria for passing?

- Yes:
 - No citation
 - Topic clearly missed
 - No declaration of originality
 - Plagiarism
 - Missing exam performance

→ lead to automatic failure.

17. Is a declaration of independence required?

- Yes. This must be confirmed by checking a box each time it is submitted. It can also be integrated directly into the file.

18. May I exceed the maximum number of pages or video length required?

- No. Anything exceeding the maximum permitted length will not be counted.

19. What are typical mistakes?

- Missing or unsuitable sources
- Inadequate citation
- Neglect of formal guidelines
- Lack of visualization
- Unclear argumentation or irrelevant content

20. How do I obtain my transcript?

- Your certificate will be made available via WueCampus after all grades have been corrected – either as “pass” or “fail.”

21. How can I submit my grade?
